Guest Faculty

Catherine Garratt Fothergill - A native of Birmingham, Alabama, Catherine is a principal dancer with the Alabama Ballet and has performed leading roles in much of the classical repertoire including Romeo and Juliet, Don Quixote, Giselle, Dracula, La Sylphide, and George Balanchine's The Nutcracker; as well as works by Frederick Ashton, Agnes De Mille, Michael Fothergill, Jirí Kylián, Twyla Tharp, and Antony Tudor. Catherine began teaching in 2008, for an outreach program of the Alabama Ballet, providing underprivileged children with dance education. She is currently on faculty with the Alabama Ballet School and The Pointe Dance Arts, where she was the Ballet Mistress and Director of Outreach through 2014. Catherine travels throughout the United States and abroad as a guest teacher, guest artist, coach, and ballet mistress. In Japan, she was the ballet mistress for international choreographer Michael Fothergill, and served as ballet mistress for the Japan Ballet Association's 37th Zendo Ballet Festival.

Tracy Halloran Pearson - Detroit native, Tracy Halloran Pearson, received her B.F.A. in Dance Performance from Marygrove College and is currently a M.F.A. candidate in Choreography at the University of Michigan. She has been the rehearsal director for works choreographed by Peter Sparling, Artistic Director of Peter Sparling Dance Company, Dennis Caspary, Los Angeles choreographer, and Sidra Bell, Artistic Director of Sidra Bell Dance New York. Tracy has choreographed works for Illinois Ballet Theater, the Marygrove College Dance Company, the University of Michigan's Department of Dance, The Academy Dance Alliance, and Dance Masters of Michigan. Most recently, Tracy produced and choreographed a performance in Detroit entitled Intersections at the Rabbit Hole. She has been an instructor at the American College Dance Festival, the University of Michigan, Marygrove College in Detroit, and various studios in the Chicago and Detroit metropolitan areas.

Syllabi classes will be presented by CCA Examiners; NS I/II (Non-Syllabus) by members of the Eastern Michigan Committee.
